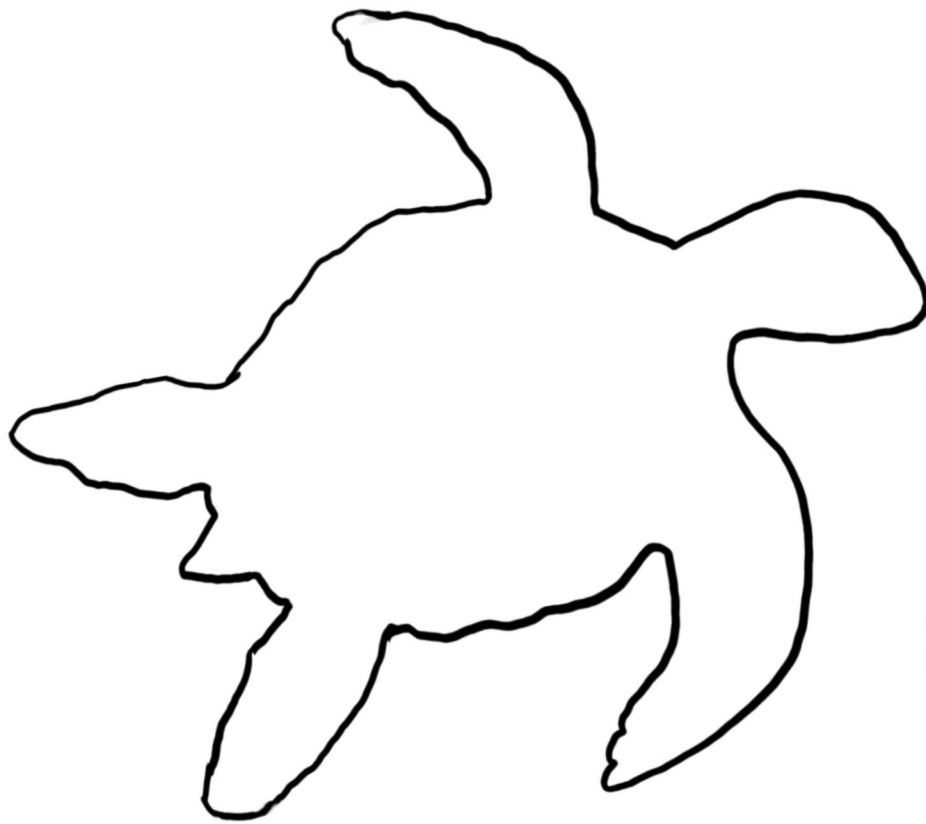




Types of sea turtles graphic from State of Hawai'i Division of Aquatic Resources website

There are 7 types of sea turtles, and 5 can be found around Hawaii. Scan the QR code and scroll down to see the differences in the turtles. Draw the scute pattern (top of shell) of one you might see in Hawaii, on the blank sea turtle. The green sea turtle (or honu to Hawaiians) is most commonly seen in Hawaii.

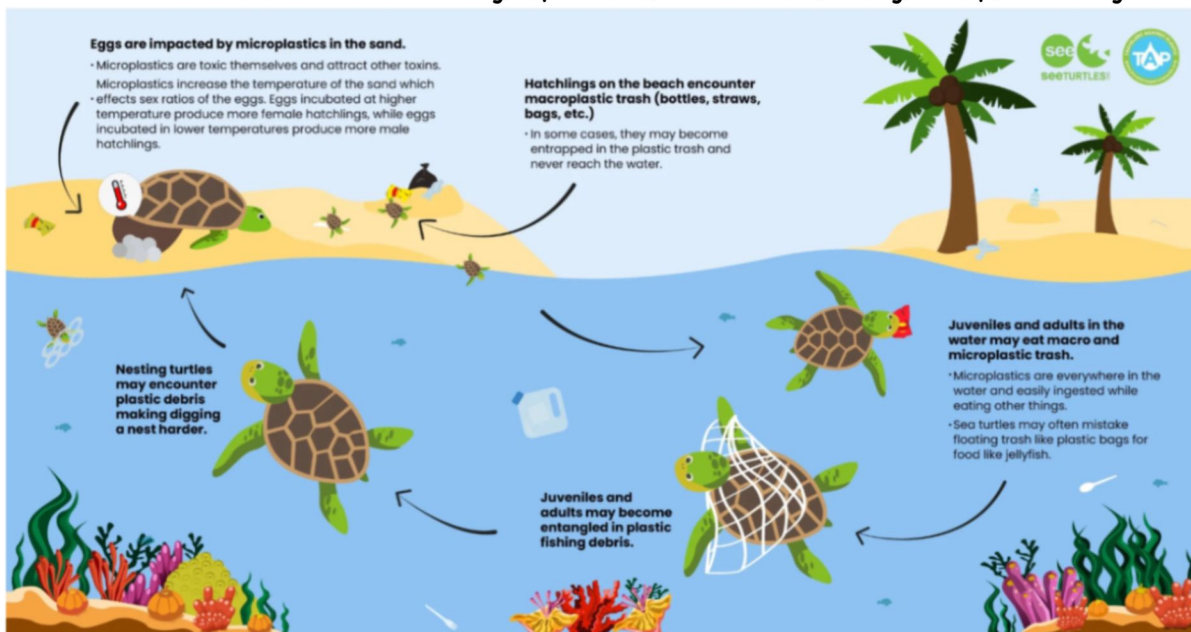
What can sea turtles teach us about living for Christ?

Sea turtles use the earth's magnetic field to navigate and to find their way back to their natal beach (where they hatched) to lay eggs. When the eggs hatch, the hatchlings also use the moonlight and the slope of the sand to find their way into the water. They can get confused by what's called light pollution - the light given off by artificial lights around the beach. Like sea turtles, we can get confused by "pollution" as well. We need to follow the only true source of light - Jesus. The Bible gives us our "direction." How does this scripture help us to keep our directional settings on the Lord?
